This is Capio S:t Görans Hospital

Capio S:t Görans is an emergency hospital for adult patients, situated at Kungsholmen in Stockholm. Capio S:t Görans is one of the most centrally placed hospitals in Stockholm, and one of the country's largest counting the number of received patients. During the year of 2008 we had over 60 000 visits at our ECU.

Capio S:t Görän is large enough to offer a broad spectrum of 31 medical specialities, but at the same time just small enough for all employees to be able to influence decision-making.

In one way Capio S:t Görän's differs completely from other hospitals in Sweden, since 1994 being the first and so far only privately owned emergency hospital in the country. Since the year 2000 we are part of Capio, one of Europe's leading health care companies.

Our cooperation with other county-owned hospitals in Stockholm still is strong. Since fall 2007 we perform heart surgeries commissioned by Karolinska University Hospital in order to shorten their waiting list.

Environmental certification

Capio S:t Görans Hospital is environmentally certified since 2005 using the standard of ISO 14001. This means that we keep a close look at how our operations effect the environment – how we dispose of out-of date pharmaceuticals, how we sort and collect trash and how we deliver food to our patients. In all major decisions our environmental footprint is an important consideration. Yearly we are monitored by independent inspectors, as well as our own environmental control staff.

Quality and safety

Having medical quality and safety as top priority at a hospital should surprise none. Here at Capio S:t Görans hospital we feel however that it's just as important to share our results, so since the past 14 years we annually present an open quality report detailing care results.

We also participate in 24 national quality registers, comparing results of surgical procedures and treatments at hospitals in Sweden. In almost all of these we perform at the national average or better – in some cases as in the treatment of heart attack we do significantly better.

To know how our patients really feel about the quality of healthcare we also continuously send them quality surveys. The number of satisfied patients steadily hovers around 90%.

Did you know that...

... we offer Steamplicity food to all our patients. This way our patients receive tasty, nutritionally balanced meals cooked whenever they choose, with 18 choices on the menu each day.

.... we have a Mobile Intensive Care Unit with specially trained personnel on 24/7 call duty. Whenever a patient's condition suddenly deteriorates at a ward the mobile ICU can be called on, providing better quality of care and improved safety

How does public care in private ownership work?

At Capio S:t Görans hospital we receive and admit all patients, with no extra charge compared to county hospitals. All care is financed through taxes, just as at the county's own hospitals. This financing is based on a care agreement with Stockholm County running to 2012.

Both patients and taxpayers benefit from Capio S:t Görans being operated as privately owned company. Since privatization in 1999 our costs has been below

average for all hospitals in Stockholm, while providing the same or better quality of care.

We work more efficiently – not by pushing our staff harder - but by developing new, better ways to work, investing in technology and providing our co-workers with the tools to manage improvement themselves. The distance between shop floor and management is short, getting new ideas and initiatives off the ground quickly.
